CREDIT: From KCTCS to UK

New Transfer Policies for Credit Earned at KCTCS Schools

Beginning Spring 2007, the following procedures will be used to apply work earned at KCTCS schools toward UK credit:

GPA

Grades transferred to UK from any KCTCS institution **will no longer be computed in the UK GPA**. All students will begin with a new GPA once they begin courses at UK.

Repeat Options

Repeat options from any KCTCS institution will no longer be honored. For admissions purposes, repeated courses (quality points) will be figured into the transferring GPA.

Academic Bankruptcy

Academic bankruptcy filed at any KCTCS institution will no longer be honored. For admissions purposes, the applicant's GPA will be computed using all grades received at the KCTCS institution.

67 Hour Rule

Applicants transferring from a KCTCS institution(s) will be limited to transferring only 67 credit hours from their KCTCS institution(s). **Please note:** If an applicant is transferring credit from more than one KCTCS institution or any other two-year institution, this will be a total of only 67 credit hours from all schools combined.

Residency Requirement

The University requires that 30 of the last 36 hours of course work completed toward a degree must be from the University of Kentucky. KCTCS course work will no longer count in this 30 hours.

Technical Campuses

UK will accept credit for courses completed at the technical campuses of KCTCS.

University Honors

Effective Fall 2006, KCTCS course work will not be used in the calculation of the GPA for determining eligibility for University honors, i.e., Summa, Magna or Cum Laude.
